

What evidence we have suggests that the open ended saggars were made by extruding the clay to a thickness of c. 15mm then cut into section and lutted together by being cut on the angle (253 c). The peg holes in vertical rows of 4 were almost certainly made with a punch with a round handle or stop whose impression can be seen on the exterior saggers (253 b)


